Below you can find a list with the workshops included in the conference programme:

- 1. Workshop 1 'Doing research towards a DFD: Bibliographical resources and databases'** (October 25, 11:00-12:30 - ROOM 01)  
This workshop will show how you can access online resources and databases for journal articles, books and theses at the University of Valencia library and do bibliography searches for academic work.
- 2. Workshop 2 'The Final Degree Project in English: structure and form'** (October 25, 15:30-17:30 - ROOM S06)  
This workshop will provide you with valuable information on the structure you must follow when writing your project.
- 3. Workshop 3 'Brainstorming for research in translation and interpreting'** (October 26, 10:30-11:30 - ROOM 104)  
After presenting the main lines of research in translation and interpreting, this workshop will help you put up a tentative proposal for a research dissertation.
- 4. Workshop 4 'The oral presentation of your DFD: the icing on the cake'** (October 26, 15:30-16:30 - ROOM 104)  
This workshop will give you the right tools to do a successful oral presentation for your projects and/or dissertations.
- 5. Workshop 5 'Performing Sentiment Analysis'** (October 26, 16:50-18:20 - Salón de Actos Manuel Sanchis Guarner)

In this workshop, you will become familiar with one of the tools used in corpus linguistics, i.e. the Linmotif software. As this is a practical session, bring your laptops (Macs, Windows 7 or later versions will do).
